1. Registration

The training is reserved exclusively for members of the association.

2. Training folder (paramedical guide)

Registration fee and guide CHF 450.00

3. Requirements profile

Persons who meet the following admission criteria will be admitted to the examination:

- Certificate of certified dermapigmentologist®
- At least 3 days of further training in the field of paramedical pigmentation.
- 2-day preparatory course Paramedical pigmentation
- Proof of 1 year of professional experience in the field of medical PMU
- Basic knowledge of skin anatomy and physiology
- Regular professional practice in a professionally equipped business premises/practice.
- Completion of the compulsory hygiene and first aid course within the last 2 years.

4. 2-day preliminary course

1. Registration

Once your registration has been received, the following documents are required to verify your qualifications:

- Copies of basic and advanced training certificates
- Last job-specific hygiene course, no older than 2 years
- Copy of passport

Submission of 3 treatments. Contents: Procedure, documentation of the entire treatment, before and after **pictures** of the treatment, video of the work rooms, photo of the work surface. Use of materials. Declaration of consent and care procedure.

The experts will review the submitted documents and grant approval for the examination. If the documents are not complete when first submitted, the association will inform you in writing of what is missing. After the second submission of your documents, an additional processing fee of CHF 50 will be charged.
